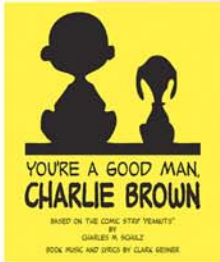
### JESS CLEMONS- 6:30PM-7:30PM

BEFORE MOVING TO NANTUCKET SUSAN WAS A MEMBER OF THE BAND ROCKFISH BASED IN SOUTHERN MARYLAND. ROCKFISH WAS KNOWN AS THE BAND THAT "PLAYED HARD AND TRAVELED LIGHT." IN 2004 ROCKFISH RELEASED A CD ENTITLED "SHADY GROVE" WHICH IS A COLLECTION OF FAVORITE COVER SONGS. SUSAN PLANS TO RETURN TO THE STUDIO VERY SOON IN ORDER TO RECORD A CD OF HER ORIGINAL SONGS.
