ACTING & DESIGN

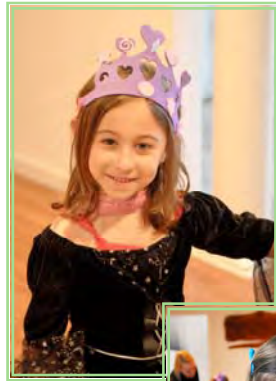

A club for kids and teens designed to expose, educate and enrich the knowledge and passion of young filmmakers. Sign up for one class or the entire series.

M103 - Live Filmmaking Basics: *In the Junior Filmmakers of Nantucket we will learn the complete process of film making. Our first assignment is to produce a short 5 minute film about "My Nantucket.". In pre production the class will collaboratively write a screen play. The team will then flesh out the production details through improvisation and role playing to create a production plan and story board. In production each film maker will have the opportunity to try various roles and responsibilities from director to actor. In post production each film maker will have the opportunity to learn basic film computer editing to edit their work and add music. The final product will be a short multimedia team production piece that will also be shown on the Nantucket Dreamland web site and published on the Dreamland's YouTube Channel. In addition each student will get a DVD copy of their work. (Materials Included)*

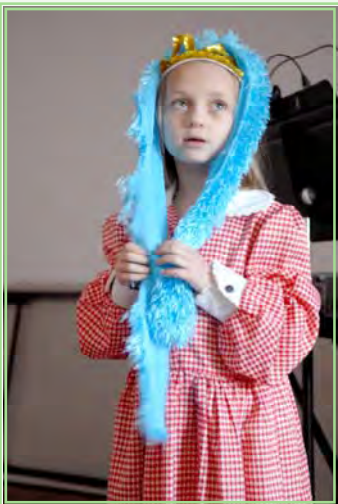
